



Milwaukee Junior Fire Institute Summer Camp Rules

1. No one may leave camp without permission. If you leave, written permission is required.
2. No alcohol, firecrackers, weapons, tobacco or drugs are permitted in camp. Check medications with health personnel. Violators will be sent home without refund.
3. All campers will be at their assigned location at all times.
4. Campers who bring a car must leave it parked during camp hours.
5. Campers are not permitted in others' belongings.
6. Campers will be charged for the cost of any physical facility and/or resource damage for which they are responsible.
7. Campers are not permitted to have cell phones in camp. A phone is available for necessary calls. Cell phones use is permitted during approved times.
8. Student's bare full responsibility for personal items brought with them to camp.
9. Campers shall follow all health and safety regulations.
10. Milwaukee Fire Department and Milwaukee Junior Fire Institute are not responsible for loss, theft or damage to all personal items brought to camp. **Please leave valuable items at home.**
11. Absolutely no posting to Social Media during their time in camp.
12. Students and their parents are solely responsible for medications required during the stay. Detailed written instructions must be left with staff at check in.
13. All attendees will be clean shaven, no facial hair. Long hair styles shall be pulled back, in a ponytail and off the shoulder.
14. Students may not be under any monitoring system with law enforcement.
15. Students will be on time and in the correct location to all classes and events.
